Former Woodford Aerodrome Site Supplementary Planning Document Adoption Statement January 2013

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 that Stockport Metropolitan Borough Council adopted the above-mentioned Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 14th January 2013.

The SPD is intended to provide guidance for the future development of the Woodford Aerodrome site and illustrate how relevant policy requirements of the Borough's Development Plan might be best met to ensure the delivery of a development that is economically, socially and environmentally sustainable.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after 14th January 2013.
